Development Programme

Objectives

This training is tailored to suit the requirement of prospective youth leaders who are interested to lead youth organisations and to those who are willing to consolidate or further develop their leadership skills.

About the Training

The Training is based on the experiential learning approach. It will be delivered in two parts.

During the first part, the trainee will undergo ten classroom sessions involving lectures, games and dynamic interactive exercises.

The second part will focus on practical projects. The participant will be called upon to team up for the implementation of a community project/ school-based project of their choice whereby, knowledge and skills acquired during the sessions will be put into practice

For those who are already playing leadership roles in an organisation (e.g. School Prefect/ Head Prefect, or School based club President etc) it will be an opportunity for them to bridge the gap between what they already know and what they should also know.

The Programme will be delivered by trained Youth Cadres of the Ministry and where mandates, external resource persons will step in. After successful completion of the course, a certificate will be awarded to participant.
